6. Financial Need

Tell us about your financial situation. Be sure to include a document that shows your EFC from the FAFSA when emailing your application.

3 TWO WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Attach two written recommendations to your email.
- At least one recommendation must be from a high school faculty member.
- The recommendations should address the following topics:
 - Motivation Student has positive goals and objectives.
 - Citizenship Student understands and practices social responsibility.
 - Leadership Student shows ability in guiding others.
 - Scholarship Student has potential for post-high school studies.
