SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Pacific Crest offers four \$1,000 scholarships to deserving students in our communities. Selection is based on the applicant's service in the community, academic performance, county of residence, and financial need. The scholarships are named for Pacific Crest board members who cared deeply about the credit union and made a big impact during their time with us.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a member in good standing with Pacific Crest Federal Credit Union.
- Applicant must be a 2018 graduating senior from a high school located in the communities served by Pacific Crest Federal Credit Union.
- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited public or private college, community college or technical college.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must submit:
 - Signed application.
 - Most recent semester high school transcript, grade point average, aptitude test scores and attendance records.
 - A one-page, typed essay telling us about yourself. Include details about your goals and aspirations, extracurricular activities, volunteer and community involvement, leadership experiences, awards and honors, work experience, degree(s) you will earn, and any other personal information you find relevant.

- ◆ **Cooperation** – Works well with others.
- ◆ **Scholarship** – Potential for post-high school studies.
- ◆ **Citizenship** – Understands and practices social responsibility.

Need shall be determined by examining the applicant's budget and income tax returns, as well as the applicant's parents household budget and income tax returns. Please complete the attached student budget worksheet. All financial information will be kept confidential. **Applications received without this information will not be considered.**
