Each year Pacific Crest offers four, \$1,000 scholarships to deserving students in our communities. Selection is based on the applicant's service in the community, academic performance, leadership, and financial need. The scholarships are named for past Pacific Crest board members who cared deeply about the credit union and made a big impact during their time with us.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be a member in good standing with Pacific Crest Federal Credit Union. To apply for membership, visit www.mypcfcu.org/join
- Applicant must be a 2021 graduating senior living in the communities served by Pacific Crest Federal Credit Union (Klamath, Lake, Modoc or NE Siskiyou Counties).
- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited public or private college, university, community college, or technical college.

 - 4 E-sign the application

2. Citizenship

Tell us how you've helped make your community better. If tracked, include number of hours you've spent in service to your community.

3. Leadership

Tell us how you've demonstrated the ability to lead others. Be sure to attach any supporting documents when emailing your application.

4. Scholarship

Tell us how you've done academically. Be sure to attach your most recent transcript and SAT/ACT test results when emailing your application.

5. Awards/Honors

Tell us about any awards or honors you've received. Be sure to attach any supporting documents when emailing your application.

6. Financial Need

Tell us about your financial situation. Be sure to include a document that shows your EFC from the FAFSA when emailing your application.

③ TWO WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Attach two written recommendations to your email.
- At least one recommendation must be from a high school faculty member.
- The recommendations should address the following topics:
 - Motivation - Student has positive goals and objectives.
 - Citizenship - Student understands and practices social responsibility.
 - Leadership - Student shows ability in guiding others.
 - Scholarship - Student has potential for post-high school studies.

④ . SIGN THE APPLICATION

- Complete applications will be reviewed by our scholarship committee. Recipients will be notified by phone no later than May 1, 2021.
- Scholarship recipients must submit proof of enrollment no later than November 1, 2021. Funds will then be disbursed directly to the school with instructions to be applied to the recipient's account.
